

MOHAIR LEECH TIED BY: Lorie Hagen

This is a great leech pattern. It can be tied in black, red, olive or any of your favorite fish catching colors. If you are fishing in deeper water you can add bead head eyes, cone head or lead to the hook shank for extra weight.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

HOOK | 285 | Size 8 - 10

BODY | Mohair Plus / Olive

Tail | Marabou | Olive

Dubbing Twister

THREAD | Olive

BOBBIN | Rite Half Hitch

VICE | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice with Midge Jaw

Dubbing Brush

SOFT BODY | Thick and Thin



« Step 1

Tie on your thread and stop at the hook bend. Place your Marabou feather atop the hook shank to make the tail. The tail should be the length of the hook shank. Secure at the bend of the hook and wrap forward to secure. Trim excess and finish wrapping forward to the eye of the hook then back to where you tied in the tail.



« Step 2

Using your dubbing tool make a dubbing loop and bring your thread forward. Place your Mohair in the dubbing loop and twist. Wrap dubbing to the hook eye and whip finish.



« Step 3

Take your dubbing brush and brush out the Mohair body. You want the Mohair to be bushy. Apply soft body thin and get ready to catch some fish.
