

BASS BULLY

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This fly works great for Bass. You can change it up by using different colored legs or for a faster sink rate use larger eyes. Make sure to tie a few different colors and sizes before you hit the water.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

HOOK | LL Hook #810 Bass Hook | Size 1/0

TAIL | Zonker Strip | Chartreuse

ABDOMEN | Estaz | Chartreuse
| Chenille | Red

HEAD | Barbell Eyes
| Mohair Plus | Chartreuse

THREAD | Big Fly Thread | Chartreuse

VICE | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice with Midge Jaw

« Step 1

Start your thread and position it at the back of the hook. Cut a strip of Zonker the length of the shaft. On one end cut a small amount of fur off so that you can tie it in. You want to tie the zonker on upside down so that the leather side is facing up.



⤴ Step 2

Tie in a piece of Estaz and wrap around the hook not quite 1/2 way. Tie off and trim excess. Take a piece of chenille and tie in. Wrap thread forward a couple of turns. You want to make a ball with the chenille. Make 2 wraps side by side, then the 3rd wrap needs to be in the center of the first to. Tie off and cut excess.



« Step 3

Take 2 strips of your legs and hold the ends together to form a loop and cut in 1/2. Place the legs in front of the chenille ball and tie in. Repeat on the other side. Trim excess legs off the front. You should have 4 legs on both sides. Now you need to tie in your barbell eyes with a figure 8.



« Step 4

Bring your thread back to where you tied in your legs and make a dubbing loop. Place mohair into the dubbing loop. I use a little more dubbing here than normal to get a buggier affect. You well need to do this a couple of times. Make sure to dub over the eyes. Tie off and whip finish.
