

## KREELEX FLY

TIED BY: Lorie Hagen

This fly was originally designed by Chuck Kraft. It has a lot of movement and light. It is very easy to tie and the flash material make it very durable. You can also tie it unweighted or in gold and copper and in size 2-8. Works great for bass, brown/rainbow/brook and cutthroat trout.

**MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- BODY** | LL Angel Flash | Silver
- WING** | LL Angel Flash | Silver
- TAIL** | LL Angel Flash | Silver
- BEARD** | Angel Flash | Gold
- THREAD** | White Nylon
- HOOK** | LL 700 Streamer | Size 6
- EYE** | Barbell Eyes | Brass | Size 3/16 (style 82)
- VICE** | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice with Midge Jaw
- TOOLS** | Rite Bobbin & Whip Finisher

### « Step 1

Tie in your barbell eyes with a figure 8, making sure to leave enough room to tie the head of the eye. Bring your thread back to the hook point.



### « Step 2

Take a clump of silver flash and wrap around your thread. Bring up to the top of the hook and tie down. Take your thread back to the eye of the hook. Trim the tail to a shank length long.

### « Step 3 »

Take another clump of silver flash and wrap around your thread and tie in, in front of the eyes (figure 3-1). Once that is secured bring the flash over the center of the eyes and tie down behind the eyes (figure 3-2). Then move your thread back to the eye of the hook. Trim the wing to just past the start of the tail.

### « Step 4

Rotate vice so the the fly is upside down. Take a clump of gold flash and wrap around your thread and tie in, in front of the eye. Finish head and whip finish. Trim the beard at the hook bend.



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
