MATERIALS NEEDED:

- HOOK | 270| Size 10-14
- BODY | Larva Lace Body Material| Brown
- TAIL | Very small tuft of peacock herl
- WING | Deer Hair, tied very sparse
- HEAD | Thread and ends of deer hair wing
- BOBBIN | Rite Half Hitch Mag
- VICE | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice with Midge Jaw
- THREAD | TAN



« Step 1

Start your thread behind the hook eye and wrap back to the hook bend. Take 3 peacock herls and tie in with a couple of wraps. I like to take the long end and fold over to the rear and tie down for extra durability. Trim off extra.



« Step 2

Cut a piece of brown body material at an angle for easier tie in. Tie in at the tail. wrap your thread forward to the hook eye. Wrap the body material forward, make sure to leave enough room for the head/wing. Place a couple of thread wraps to hold the body material in place. Pull body material tight and place a couple more wraps of thread to secure. Trim off extra body material.



« Step 3

Cut a small amount of deer hair for the wing. Place on top of the hook so that the wing is as long as the hook and tie in. Bring your thread forward and place a couple of half hitches to finish. Trim wing/head.



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
