

## GREEN LARVA TIED BY: Lorie Hagen

This fly is easy to tie and it catches fish. If you are fishing fast water and need to fish it deep you can add lead to the hook shank or use split shot. Without the weight you can use as a dropper behind a dry fly in shallow water. You can also coat the body of the fly with soft body for a different look and added durability.

**MATERIALS NEEDED:**

- HOOK** | 730 Nymph | Sz 12-16
- THREAD** | UNI | Brown | 8/0
- BODY** | SSS Holo Braid | Gaudy Green
- HEAD** | MOHAIR PLUS | BROWN OLIVE
- VICE** | Hagen's Deluxe Stainless Steel Vice
- BOBBIN** | Rite Bobbin | Half Hitch Mag
- WEIGHT** | Optional | Lead or Split Shot

### « Step 1

Start your thread behind the eye of the hook and wrap to the bend of the hook. Tie in a piece of the Holo Braid and wrap your thread back toward the eye of the hook.



### « Step 2

Take the Holo Braid you tied in and wrap forward, tie off. Make sure to leave room for the head of the fly.



### « Step 3

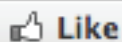
Using a small amount of the Mohair twist onto your thread ( or you can use a dubbing loop). You want the head to be slightly larger than the body of the fly. Place a couple of half hitches and get ready to catch some fish!!
