

ESTAZ SALMON FLY

This fly works great for Silver and Chinook Salmon. You can tie it in a variety of colors like: pink, chartreuse, orange, red, purple, purple with a orange head, and pink with a chartreuse head. You can also tie them with or without eyes. Make sure to tie a few differant sizes. The later in the season and the more flies the fish see they tend to get a little pickier. When this happens the smaller flies seem to work best.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

HOOK | 930 Saltwater | Size 6-1/0
EYE'S | Barbell | Black
BODY | Estaz
TAIL | Angel Hair| Pearl Green, Gold or Purple
THREAD | 6/0
BOBBIN | Rite Half Hitch
VICE | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice
HEAD CEMENT | Flex Lock



« Step 1

Lay down a good bed of thread from the hook eye to the point. Take a small clump of angel hair and clip the ends so they are even. Tie in for the tail. (You want it to be the lenght of the hook shank) fold over and place a couple of thread wrap to secure, trim to length.



« Step 2

Bring your thread forward. You want to tie in your eyes about a 1/3 of the shank length behind the hook eye. Tie in eyes using a figure 8. Bring your thread back to the tail.



« Step 3

Tie in a piece of estaz and wrap thread forward. Wrap the estaz forward. When you get to the eyes you want to bring it over the eye and back around to the back of the eye and wrap once, then back over the eye and wrap forward. Tie off and trim excess. Whip finish and apply head cement.
