

CASCADE GOLD TIED BY: Lorie Hagen

The first time I fished this fly was in Cascade MT on the Missouri River. The first cast it produced a big beautiful rainbow. Then on the Sheilds River north of Livingston MT I tied it on and the first cast I caught a nice trout. I had alot of fun that week, the cascade gold never let me down.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

HOOK | 070| Size 12 or 300| size 14

BODY | Silverlined Glass Beads / Gold

Tail | Super Floss | Black

WING | Poly Bear | Rusty Brown & Black

THREAD | Uni8/0 |Blck

BOBBIN | Rite Half Hitch

VICE | Hagen's Deluxe Fly Tying Vice with Midge Jaw

Whip Finisher

HEAD CEMENT| FLEX LOCK



« Step 1

Pinch the barbs on the hook, this makes it easier to slip the beads on. Place 3 gold beads onto the hook. Then place in your vice.



« Step 2

Tie your thread on at the bend of the hook. I like to lean the jaw of my vice down so that the beads stay out of the way. Take a 1-2" piece of super floss. Hold your thread below the fly. Fold the super floss around the thread from the back. Wrap your thread around the hook shank so that the super floss is on the top of the hook shank. Hold both peices off the rear of the hook shank and tie down. Whip finish and trim tail.



« Step 3

I put my vise back up to finish the fly. Push the beads towards the tie in for the tail. Tie on your thread at the eye of the hook. Take a small amount of rusty brown poly bear along with a small piece of black. The black needs to be on top of the rusty brown. Tie in for a wing with a couple of wraps leaving about a 1" piece hanging in front of the hook eye. Take the front piece and bring it down toward the hook point and place a couple of wraps to hold in place. Whip finish. Trim The bottom off just in front of the hook point. The top wing you want to trim off where you tied in the tail. Apply flex lock and get ready to catch some fish.
